### ***Two Education Scholarships of \$500 each for Qualifying Graduating High School Seniors in the Class of 2012***

- **St. Barbara Knights of Columbus Scholarship**  
Two \$500 scholarships in memory of Martin Bratkovich to be awarded by the Knights of Columbus.

#### **RETAIN THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR RECORDS**

The Knights of Columbus Council 14078 is offering two scholarships for the sons and daughters of St. Barbara Parish members. Each scholarship entitles the awardees to receive up to \$500 to defray expenses for tuition, books, or maintenance in any college or school of nursing approved by the committee. Acceptance of one of these scholarships does not preclude the winner from enjoying any other scholarship the awardees may win unless other restrictions prevail.

#### **CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD**

*Each candidate must be at least one of the following:*

- a son or daughter of a registered member of the St. Barbara Parish in Harrison City, PA.
- a son or daughter of a deceased registered member of the St. Barbara Parish in Harrison City, PA.

*Other conditions that must be met:*

- the candidate must be a practicing Catholic in communion with the Holy See
- the candidate must be a candidate for graduation from a recognized 4-year high school, or its equivalent, in June 2012 (or January 2012 for early graduates)
- the candidate must apply no later than **March 14, 2012**, to the Scholarship Committee of the Knights of Columbus Council 14078, using the form attached or an exact duplicate thereof. The application must include signatures of the applicant, parent or guardian, pastor or associate pastor of the applicant, and an official in the applicant's school verifying that the applicant is a candidate for graduation in 2012.

Each scholarship winner must apply to a college or to a school of nursing affiliated with a hospital in order to receive payment. Such college or school may be under Catholic or non-Catholic auspices, subject to approval by the committee. Payments will be made to the school directly, not to the winner.

## **HOW TO PROCEED**

To compete for a Knights of Columbus Council 14078 Scholarship, you MUST:

1. Complete the application on the next page and send it before **March 14, 2012** to:

The application may be dropped off at the parish office instead of mailed.
2. Register and take either the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) of the College Board or the American College Testing (ACT) Program.

IMPORTANT -- ACT or SAT scores from test dates later than December 31, 2011 will not be accepted.

### **SELECTION OF WINNERS**

Selection of the winning applicants in will be made by the Scholarship Committee.

### **METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The \$500 award to the winning candidates will be paid directly to the school they attend for tuition, books, and maintenance.

The school is to invoice the St. Barbara Knights of Columbus Council 14078.

### **DEADLINE DATE TO APPLY**

Your application must be postmarked by **March 14, 2012**. Any application postmarked after that date will be ineligible for consideration.
